For your safety and the protection of the preserves:

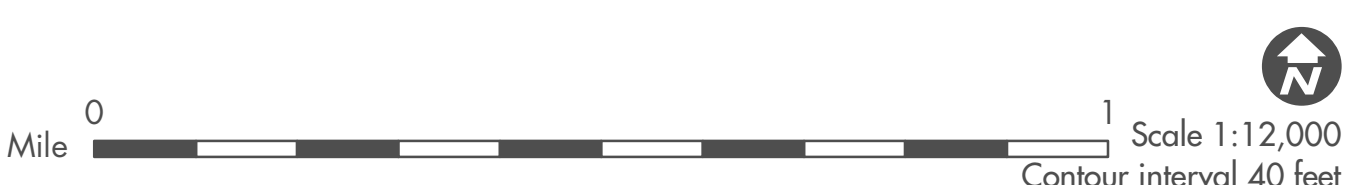
The preserve is open one-half hour before official sunrise until one-half hour after official sunset.
